In five (5) pages or less, please provide a typed response to all of the following questions:

- 1. How has the nominee demonstrated a sustained contribution to ethical animal care and use (including the Three Rs) by going above and beyond throughout their professional career?
- 2. How has the nominee demonstrated their commitment to ethical animal care and use through their volunteer service?
- 3. How has the nominee demonstrated a significant contribution to the CCAC? What roles have they played? (e.g., committee/subcommittee/working group, animal care committee, institutional engagement, assessment panels, training initiatives, ad hoc projects)?
- 4. How has the nominee demonstrated their commitment to empowering and uplifting others, particularly in the areas of equity, diversity, and inclusion?
- 5. How does the nominee meet the objectives of this award?

No cover letters or additional materials will be accepted as part of the nomination package or included in the evaluation of the nominee. All responses must be typed, in an 11-point font, and in PDF format.

Nomination packages must be received by March 1, 2026 at 11:59 p.m. EDT to be considered for the 2026 award. Please send completed nomination packages to the CCAC at <a href="mailto:nominations@ccac.ca">nominations@ccac.ca</a> (nominations will be accepted by email only).
